The rendering illustrates the concept put forth by Diamond & Schmitt Architects in their master plan prepared in 2002 proposing conservation and repurposing of the Memorial Library for inclusion in an exciting Fine and Performing Arts Centre for Mount Allison University. The perspective is a view of the proposed Arts Centre as you approach the university from the east along Main Street. The concept treasures the architectural heritage of the campus as expressed in the conserved Memorial Library, venerates this cenotaph mandated by the Regents to honour the young Allisonians “who have made the supreme sacrifice in behalf of our country” in the Great War, respects the will of their families and friends to have “a lasting tribute”, and through physical form celebrates the diversity of the cherished liberal arts teachings of Mount Allison.
